# **Applying for Articulated Credit- Student Checklist**

#### Students should:

**Student Information** 

- 1. Review the requirements for articulated credit. These may be obtained from your high school/career center or from the <u>Statewide Articulation Agreement website</u>.
- 2. Complete any required assessments or certifications that may be required to earn articulated credit.
- 3. Submit the <u>free online application to attend Ferris after high school</u>. Visit <u>www.ferris.edu/ferrisnow</u> for instructional video and "Apply Now" link.
- 4. Fill out the "Student Information" section of the Articulated Credit Application below.
- 5. Obtain the required signatures from your high school/career center instructor and administrators.
- 6. Ask you high school/career center to submit the Articulated Credit Application to Ferris on your behalf.

- 1. Verify the student meets the requirements posted on the <u>Statewide Articulation Agreement website.</u>
